4. New Business

A. Fire Radio IGA

- The Board discussed the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for fire radio procurement between ETSB and DU-COMM.
- A single IGA will be used for all fire agencies, mirroring the existing police IGA.
- Agencies must certify that radios funded by ETSB are used for first responder purposes.

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- Two documents were introduced:
 - Certification Document (to be attached to the IGA)
 - Authorization Letter (acknowledging DU-COMM is entering the IGA on behalf of the agency)
- Discussion included:
 - Billing consistency (ETSB vs. DU-COMM).
 - This IGA will supersede prior agreements for Bartlett, Carol Stream, and Warrenville.
 - o Clarification of maintenance responsibilities and billing.
 - Concerns about individual liability for fire chiefs.

Mayor Craig made a motion to approve to authorize the Chair to sign the IGA on behalf of DU-COMM with the two attachments, including an amendment to the Authorization Letter to reflect "DU-COMM/ETSB" as the billing entity as presented, and Administrator Walter seconded. Motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote.
