  - Coordination with ETSB, County, and all Agencies on public education possibly in April.
  - County is also updating 211 and 988.
  - Texts will sit in a queue until a TC is available.
- Encryption.
- Need radio consoles installed. Scheduled for the end of March.
- Train the trainer begins February 26<sup>th</sup>. Ten people will be trained as trainers to train other employees.

- Staffing numbers were reviewed:
  - 73 out of 99 authorized TC positions are currently filled.
  - One TC is evaluating Fire radio tonight.
  - An additional Fire radio trainee should evaluate at the end of the month.
